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EDITORIAL

To speak of research is to put the subject in connection with knowledge, a subject systematically created and contrasted in the process of training students at the university, which leads us to implement formative research models. The Dolphin Program proposed the Virtual Stay XXV Summer of Scientific and Technological Research of the Pacific 2020, which is why Universidad César Vallejo received 26 Mexican students from the Universities of Guadalajara, Autónoma de Nayarit, Mexiquense del Bicentenario, who have joined teaching projects whose lines of research were of interest to them. The 26 interns were received by 05 researchers from our university from Lima Norte and Chiclayo campuses. All the interns had access to the virtual library of our university during the seven weeks of the internship. The interns carried out a virtual work plan, which upon completion, reached significant achievements as scientific articles for publication.



UCV INVITED TO EFI RESEARCH GROUP

Cesar Vallejo University was invited to take part as a university in a research that has been developing the EFI Group - promoted by Consolidated Group GIPE made up of three Catalan universities (Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, Universitat de Barcelona, Universitat de Barcelona, Universitat and Peru, which have initiated a Research "stress and digital skills during remote emergency teaching" (ESHADIER).

In this sense, the Vice-Presidency of Research of the UCV, by means of Official Letter N°223-2020/VI-UCV, accepts the invitation to participate in such research, for which three (03) researchers have been appointed.

With this experience, it is sought to form an international network; the UCV researchers linked to the project will take part in webinars to discuss results and share comments with other participating universities; and, UCV will be able to publish individually or together with other universities.
